In support of growing an appreciation for technology skills among students, our Dublin team recently launched CoderDojo@MasterCard and hosted its initial session.



CoderDojo@MasterCard is a volunteer-led club that offers young people the opportunity to learn programming skills in interesting ways, socialize with peers and share their experiences working on a variety of projects. Membership is free and open to the friends and family of MasterCard employees between the ages of five and 17.

Twenty students, ages five to 15, attended the first session. Each of them expressed interest in returning for future events, a testament to the work done by MasterCard volunteers to support the initiative. Interest in the CoderDojo@MasterCard program has grown among employees as well, with more than 40 signing up to serve as mentors for future students.

A total of eight sessions will be held between April and June in Dublin. The team has partnered with the MasterCard *Women in Technology* group to examine opportunities to expand membership to local schools, with a focus on recruiting female students.
