Following the successful launch of the program in 2014, MasterCard Start Path is again welcoming innovative startups to grow their businesses through MasterCard expertise, partnerships and products.

Through February 19, startups from Europe and Israel can apply to be a part of Start Path Europe's 12-month hybrid onsite and virtual program. Selected companies will receive mentorship from MasterCard experts, introductions to MasterCard partners to explore pilot opportunities, and the ability to leverage existing MasterCard solutions.

"Start Path Europe is unique, because we tailor the support to match the individual needs of a startup, rather than applying a 'one size fits all' approach," says Stephane Wyper, global lead of Mastercard Start path. ## Eligible startups should:

- Be based in Europe or Israel
- Have a commerce-focused technology, either live or in-beta
- Be pre-Series A and have secured seed funding

The Start Path Europe program will begin in April. Participating Startups will spend the first four-months in Dublin receiving hands-on support. The remaining eight-months will be conducted virtually to allow the startups to work in their home markets.
